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Re: City Populations

The Legislative Research Department was asked to provide each legislator with a table showing population gains/losses for each city in Kansas. The attached table lists each city's 2000 Census and 2010 Census populations, the total population change, and the corresponding percent change.

The five cities adding the most residents between 2000 and 2010 are:

- Wichita (38,048 for 11.1 percent increase over the 2000 population);
- Olathe (32,910; 35.4 percent increase);
- Overland Park (24,292; 16.3 percent increase);
- Shawnee (14,213; 29.6 percent increase); and
- Gardner (9,727; 103.5 percent increase).

Thirteen Kansas cities grew by more than 50 percent, and four of those cities more than doubled in population. In total, 191 cities gained population, while 432 cities lost population.
